



**Kookaburras** are birds native to Australia and New Guinea, with size between 28 – 42 cm. They live in humid forest, savannah, suburban areas with tall trees, or near water. Kookaburras are carnivorous. Kookaburras can eat the young of other birds, mice, snakes, insects and small reptiles. They can even take meat from barbecues.



**The cougar** is a large cat native to America. It is the second heaviest cat in America, after the jaguar. Adult males are around 2.4 m long. It is solitary by nature. It is a carnivore, and can eat deer, moose, domestic cattle, horses and sheep. It will also hunt species as small as insects and rodents. This cat lives in habitats with dense vegetation and rocky areas.

They live near water because their larvae are aquatic.
