Wow kids!!! We are already in week 10! You are superpro in English now!!


Thanks for all you work at home and also thank you to all the members in your family who have to be teachers now!!

Grammar Rule

Examples

*I **am** big. I **am** 10 years old!
They **are** Egyptian. They **are** from Egypt.*


Remember!

*I **am** big. = I'm big.
You **are** my friend. = You're my friend.
My mum **is** a doctor. = My mum's a doctor.
We **are** doctors. = We're doctors.
They **are** Egyptian. = They're Egyptian.*

Be careful!

*For negatives add 'not'. The negative of 'I am' is 'I'm not' or 'I am not'.
I'm **not** 9 years old!
I **am not** 9 years old!
They're **not** English.
They **aren't** English.*

Then, there are two games you can play (haz click donde pone Game en el link de arriba)



We say... We don't say...

*I'm not 9 years old. (NOT I am n't 9 years old.)
Are you 9 years old? (NOT You are 9 years old?)
Are they English? (NOT They are English?)
Is she a teacher? (NOT She is a teacher?)*

(If you want to show surprise you can say **Pronoun + be + ?** as a question, e.g. **You're 9?**)

Resumen recordatorio Verbo To be

Verb To be: el nombre es TO Be pero se conjuga dependiendo del sujeto de la oración.

Este verbo significa ser o estar, pero también lo usan para decir cuántos años tengo.

Si el sujeto es "YO" en inglés "I" /ai/, el verbo to be se convierte en "AM".
Por ejemplo: "I am a girl" "I am tall" "I am 9 years old" que es lo mismo que decir "I'm".

Si el sujeto es "he, she or it" entonces To be se convierte en "IS":

Por ejemplo: "She is beautiful" "he is my brother" "It is in the school"

Si el sujeto es "we, they or you" se conjuga usando "ARE"

Por ejemplo: "We are friends" "They are in the pool"

Cuando se quiere decir que "NO" es decir usar el no en la oración.

Por ejemplo "él no es mi amigo" "he is not my friend" Se usa "not": I am not, he is not, she is not, we are not. Para hacerlo más corto se convierte en "isn't or aren't". **Ejemplo:** " They aren't friends"

Cuando se quieren hacer preguntas, se pone delante el verbo To be conjugado, es decir se pone AM, IS or ARE delante del sujeto.

Por ejemplo: Is she your sister? Are you okey? Are they angry with you?
