

- There is not a known way to write his last name.




He was born in Hamburg on 3rd of February 1809, an early Felix Mendelssohn was a general composer and a conductor.
He best-known works include the score of incidental music for A Midsummer Night's Dream.



It was written in 1842, as one of last pieces of the music from his suite of incidental music (Op. 61) to Shakespeare's play A Midsummer Night's Dream. It's one of the most frequently used wedding marches, generally being played over church pipe organ.

It's a musical composition that is around 45-60 minutes of the night.



It was written in 1595

- Hermia → is the daughter of Egeus
 - Oberon → is the King of Fairy and husband of Titania.
 - Titania → is the Fairy queen and wife of Oberon.
 - Puck → Goblin who serves Oberon. He openly admits to being a rogue and mischievous spirit.
 - Lysander → In love with Hermia who by Puck's magic fell temporarily in love with Helena.
 - Philostrate → Master of ceremonies for Theseus.
 - Hippolyta → Queen of the amazons and princess of Athens, wife of Theseus.
 - Demetrius → at first in love with Hermia.
 - Nick Bottom → the weaver, plays Pyramus. Puck transforms his head into a donkey.
 - Egeus → the Duke of Athens who wants Hermia to marry Demetrius.
 - Helena → in love with Demetrius and friend of Hermia.
 - Flute → the bellows blower. Plays the pipe.
 - Theseus → Duke of Athens, during his wedding he is the judge of the romantic problem.

From whatever you say say nothing


POEM
